Kisco's Release 2.0 of OnePass/400 Includes Support for Custom Application Security

Saranac Lake, NY, November 18th, 2002: Kisco Information Systems today announced the release of OnePass/400 Version 2.0. This release transforms the security tool from a Telnet sign-on control solution to a general application security engine.

OnePass/400 is part of Kisco's award winning security software suite, which includes SafeNet/400, Nsafe Lite and ScreenSafer/400. The new version further enhances this suite by offering a powerful API for adding single use, self expiring passwords to any custom application at the customer's installation.

Version 2.0 retains all the original features for blocking and auditing iSeries Telnet access. Telnet is widely used on the iSeries and AS/400 for terminal emulation, allowing users to logon from any network client. Since Telnet is

included with every other mainstream-computing platform, it leaves the system open to access from countless sources.

OnePass enables systems administrators to control Telnet user access by issuing second level passwords that can only be used one time by one user. The tool can be configured to recognize sign-on context so that second level security is only used when necessary. OnePass records every access attempt, whether accepted or rejected, in a history log file. Thwarted access attempts by unauthorized users are immediately reported to a configurable list of administrators.

Now version 2.0 extends these powerful features to any application running on iSeries or AS/400 system. Developers can use the new API to add this second level access to their applications. They can use the same access controls, real time monitoring and audit trail features as the Telnet tool, for each application on the system.

OnePass/400 is a great tool for adding second level security to mission critical applications. The product is competitively priced and includes the first year of technical support.
