Kisco Releases SafeNet/400 V8.5

Saranac Lake, NY, May 14, 2007: **Kisco Information Systems** (www.kisco.com) today announced the immediate availability of version 8.5 of SafeNte/400, their popular and industry leading solution for System i network security.

About the product

At its core, SafeNet/400 is a network security package for the IBM System i family of platforms. It uses IBM operating system exit points to protect your system from unauthorized connections from common network sources including iSeries Access, FTP and ODBC, and others. The product includes complete audit tools including access logging, audit reporting and automatic notifications. Access can be controlled through user profiles and various control parameters, such as time of day or day of week controls. Furthermore, SafeNet/400 allows you to implement these controls without changing your system configuration.

First released in 1996, SafeNet/400 was, at that time, the only available exit point based solution for network security. Now, twelve years and eight-plus releases

later, Kisco Information Systems continues to retain its position of market leadership.

New in Version 8.5

With Release 8.5, SafeNet/400 implements object level controls for the IBM operating system FTP Client program. When implemented, you can control which objects on the System i the FTP Client users will be permitted to access when connecting to various foreign systems. SafeNet/400 Release 8.5 also implements IP address controls over FTP Client sessions thereby limiting the destination IP addresses of foreign systems that an FTP Client user will be permitted to connect with. Both of these enhancements to the System i FTP Client exit point make significant security improvements on the System i.

Also, Release 8.5 of SafeNet/400 makes it easier to send automatic email notifications of security violation attempts. With this change, a list of direct email addresses can be stored within SafeNet/400. When security violation attempts are detected, a series of email notices with violation details are sent to the list of email addresses.

The SafeNet/400 Release 8.5 installation and upgrade process has also now been simplified with the use of ISO CD Image files available via download for both new customer trials and existing customer upgrades.

Release 8.5 also includes updated documentation for this interim release.

Pricing and Availability

SafeNet/400 is available in a tiered package and pricing structure that grants IT departments of different sizes and needs access to SafeNet/400's market leading protection in a more customized and efficient manner. The available packages are SafeNet/400 Lite, SafeNet/400 Basic, SafeNet/400 Advanced and SafeNet/400 Enterprise.

The Lite version provides entry-level network controls allowing shops to secure server functions at the user profile level.

The Basic package includes all of the Lite features plus network security to the object level. It also permits controls at the SQL verb level, CL command level, FTP command level and much more.

The Advanced package includes all of the Basic features, along with the availability of the Nav-Central GUI interface to manage single server environments.

The Enterprise product allows use of the Nav-Central to manage multiple iSeries and AS/400 server platforms from a single, centralized location.
