Access Controls Enhanced in Kisco's SafeNet/400 Security Solution

Mount Kisco, NY, January 11, 2002: Kisco Information Systems today announced enhancements to SafeNet/400 which further allow security administrators to limit access to iSeries and AS/400 computers from network connections.

Time-of-Day and Day-of-Week limit controls in SafeNet/400 now open and shut iSeries and AS/400 network access points, from 5250, FTP, ODBC, TCP/IP SQL and TelNet sources, at intervals designated by the security administrator.

SafeNet/400's new access controls are particularly effective in limiting access of people with user profiles who attempt to connect to the system during non-business or restricted periods. With these new Time-of-Day and Day-of-Week access control functions, users who have authority to an object are going to be limited to when they can gain access to that object. In addition to limiting Time of Day and Day of Week access, SafeNet/400 will now impose exclusion rules at the network function level that allow security administrators to define up to 20 holidays where system access is to be restricted.

SafeNet/400 offers an additional layer of security above native OS/400 object level security without making the system more difficult to use. SafeNet/400 limits and controls access through

40 + network exit points. This enables system security administrators to audit, control access to, and report on security related system activity. Alerts can be implemented to notify system administrators and officers in real time of attempts to breach system security. SafeNet/400 does not require administrators to change their system security settings or applications, and does not adopt authority. It is easy to install, administer and maintain.

Rich Loeber, President of Kisco Information Systems, states, "Networks as part of commercial production computing systems have transcended their primary purpose of facilitating connectivity between disparate devices and are emerging as the central nervous system for the business. To the degree that that there is greater diversity in these networks, there is greater risk to the business.
