## WebReport/400 New Release Converts Spooled-Files to PDF's, then Emails Them

---

Saranac Lake, NY, May 13, 2002: Kisco Information Systems ([www.kisco.com](http://www.kisco.com)) today announced several enhancements to Web/Report/400, a software solution that automates the distribution of iSeries-AS/400 reports.

Release 5 of WebReport/400 now allows AS/400 spooled-files to be automatically converted to Adobe PDF files and emailed. With new support for AFPDS and IPDS spool files, AFPDS overlays can be married to these documents to make them resemble invoices, purchase orders, statements, or any other business document. With WebReport/400, these documents no longer need to be printed and mailed; they can be created automatically on iSeries-AS/400 computers and transmitted to any number of recipients via email, as universally accepted, tamper resistant Adobe PDF documents.

WebReport/400 can monitor AS/400 output queues and transmit documents via email as they are created. Destination email addresses can be embedded directly into the spool file, or technicians can tie an email routing instruction to an output queue. Recipient lists can also be managed within an output queue by FORMTYPE. In R.5 of WebReport/400, the senders name can be specifically noted in the email's subject line.

WebReport/400 gives users a single point to make email address and output queue entries. In R.5 of WebReport/400 the user interface has also been enhanced to make use of the product more intuitive. Kisco has also made improvements to the product's help text in the new release.

OS/400 spooled-files are generated in a format that is not compatible with other systems and cannot easily be transmitted electronically to non iSeries-AS/400 systems.

WebReport/400 converts OS/400 spooled-files to common document formats which enables them to be received as email attachments by MAPI compliant email server software running on other operating systems, such as UNIX, LINUX, Windows 9X, and Windows NT/XP.

WebReport/400 also converts spooled files to local files for storage in shared folders and facilitates conversion of the report to PDF, RTF, TXT or HTML formats. When stored in the IFS and made dynamically accessible via Intranet, Extranet and Internet websites, company reports can be accessed using standard browsers.

WebReport/400 sells for \$995.00. WebReport/400 PDF, which adds support for report conversions to Adobe PDFs is priced at \$1,595.00 for any AS/400 or iSeries computer. For companies with several systems, Kisco extends a multiple system discount.
