## **Kisco Announces The Release of WebReport/400 v7.0**

---

Saranac Lake, NY, September 21, 2004: **Kisco Information Systems** ([www.kisco.com](http://www.kisco.com)) today announced the immediate availability of version 7.0 of their WebReport/400 package. WebReport/400 is an ebusiness utility for automatically converting iSeries and AS/400 reports and distributing them in email, or as internet/intranet content. The new version's features include enhanced security, FTP support, improved control over email composition and addressing, support for file name variations and the ability to email and/or store reports in spool file format. An automatic message monitoring system is also included. The overall interface and user experience has also improved and streamlined.

Webreport/400 can implement security on spool files converted to Adobe Acrobat (PDF) format. Now, Version 7.0 provides more control and a higher level of protection by adding file encryptions, user/owner passwords and the ability to set document permissions.

For the first time, Version 7.0 includes support for outbound FTP, enabling users to easily send converted reports to another system, for example from the iSeries-AS/400 to an external web server. The product ships with shell programs to facilitate FTP implementation.

The new release provides much better user control over the default text body message in the email to which reports are attached. WebReport/400's formatting capabilities also take a step forward with improved control over AFP overlay alignment.

Webreport/400 includes features for controlling the routing of emailed reports. Now, with version 7.0, a new option for automatically addressing email messages allows users to imbed a destination email address (or addresses) directly into a user controlled data field associated with the spool file. WebReport/400 can now extract those email addresses from the spool file and use them for routing the report. The new version also includes expanded control over the "from" email address for individually emailed reports.

In WebReport/400 7.0, new options are available for automatically routing spool files based on the spool file name. Also, as opposed to previous versions where the software generated default names for converted files, users can now specify a file name, or can choose to generate date-based file names.

Also in version 7.0, users will have the ability to email reports in spool file format. They will also be able to store them in the same format. These reports can then be restored to the spool on any system, facilitating archival storage of reports or the transfer of reports between systems.

Finally, Kisco has adapted WebReport/400's email engine to create an automatic message monitoring system. This is a job that will monitor any message queue on the system and send event-based email notifications according to filters that

are configured by the user. For example, if the system is set up to automatically backup without an operator and there is a tape error that halts the backup, the Message Monitor could pick up on the problem and send out an email notification.
